NEXT WEEKEND we celebrate The Second Sunday in Advent. The sermon is titled "Receive Double!" and the hymn of the day is "Comfort, Comfort Ye My People" (LSB 347). The scripture lessons for worship are:

Introit Ps. 80:1, 8a, 9b, 7; antiphon: Ps. 80:3 Restore Us, O God
O.T. (sermon text) Isaiah 40:1–11 Comfort for God's People
Epistle 2 Peter 3:8–14 The Day of the Lord Will Come
Gospel Mark 1:1-8 John the Baptist Prepares the Way

DISTRIBUTION HYMN is Come, Thou Precious Ransom, Come" (LSB 350) by Johann Gottfried Olearius (1635-1711). This hymn was translated into English by August Crull (1845-1923), who was born in Rostock, Germany, but lost his father at a young age. When his mother remarried, the family moved to the United States, and Crull eventually graduated from the Saint Louis seminary. After serving as a parish pastor, Crull taught at Concordia College in Fort Wayne, Indiana. He was known as a hymnologist, serving as the first major LCMS translator of German hymns into English. He made major contributions to the *Evangelical Lutheran Hymn Book* (1889), the hymnal for the predecessor body of the LCMS English District, to which Trinity belongs today.
