NEXT WEEKEND we celebrate The Third Sunday after Pentecost. The sermon is titled "The Promise is Eternal," and the hymn of the day is "Rise! To Arms! With Prayer Employ You" (LSB 668). The scripture lessons for worship are:

Introit Psalm 28:7–9; antiphon: v. 6 The Lord Is My Strength and My Shield

O.T. (sermon text) Genesis 3:8–15 The Fall

Epistle 2 Corinthians 4:13—5:1 *Our Heavenly Dwelling*Gospel Mark 3:20–35 *Jesus' Mother and Brothers*

HYMN OF THE DAY is "These Are the Holy Ten Commands" (LSB 581) by Martin Luther (1483-1546). Luther's catechism hymns are settings of the Chief Parts of the Small and Large Catechisms. LSB 581 opens with an introduction to the Ten Commandments (Exodus 20:1-17). We will then sing about the commandment "Remember the Sabbath day to keep it holy." The final two stanzas summarize God's law and provide a prayer, while every stanza concludes with "Have mercy, Lord" to show that we cannot earn salvation ourselves. The tune IN GOTTES NAHMEM FAHREN WIR is a 13th-c. German melody, much older than Luther's text.
