**DISTRIBUTION HYMN** is "For the Fruits of His Creation" (LSB 894) by the prolific Methodist hymn writer Fred Pratt Green (1903-2000). Born in Liverpool, he studied theology in Manchester and during his career served parishes in Brighton, York, and Norwich. The Welsh tune name AR HYD Y NOS is a translation of the words "All through the night." This phrase concludes the first stanza of "God, Who Made the Earth and Heaven" (LSB 877), the most famous hymn written for this 18<sup>th</sup>-c. melody.
