DISTRIBUTION HYMN is "How Great Thou Art" (LSB 801) by Carl G. Boberg (1859-1940). In 1885, Boberg wrote this hymn in response to the beauty of nature and ringing of church bells that he experienced while traveling through a storm. Boberg was born in Mönsterås, Sweden, the son of a shipyard carpenter. He worked as a sailor and a teacher of trades before becoming a preacher and church publication editor. From 1912 to 1931, he served in the Swedish Parliament. The tune O STORE GUD is a Swedish folk melody of unknown provenance which was first published in 1890.
