CLOSING HYMN is "Great is Thy Faithfulness" (LSB 809) by Thomas Obadiah Chisolm (1866-1960). He was born in a log cabin in Kentucky, challenged by bouts of severe illness, and beset by poverty. Sustained by his faith, his favorite scripture passage was Lamentations 3:22-23: "The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness." The tune FAITHFULNESS was composed in 1923 by William M. Runyan (1870-1957), a Methodist pastor. Late in his career, Runyan worked as an editor for the Moody Bible Institute in Chicago and Hope Publishing Company in Carol Stream. For his work in church music, Runyan received an honorary doctorate from Wheaton College in 1948. The musical style of the tune FAITHFULNESS is typical of the evangelistic movement centered at the Moody Bible Institute in the 20th century.

ST JOHN PASSION will be featured in the adult education hour starting June 30 at 9:15 am in the Trinity Center. Throughout 2024, this masterpiece is being celebrated throughout the world for its three hundredth birthday; J. S. Bach composed it in 1724 shortly after beginning his new job as Kantor in Leipzig. The St. John Passion is especially dramatic in recounting the events of Holy Week and also includes several hymns that are familiar to Lutheran congregations today. Please join us to learn more about this important musical work from the Lutheran heritage.
