ST JOHN PASSION will be featured on July 21 at 9:15 am in the Trinity Center, with the discussion covering Christ's burial. The featured hymn in this section of Bach's Passion is "Lord, Thee I Love with All My Heart" (LSB 708).

PASTOR AND DANYA INVITE YOU to a coffee hour on **Sunday, July 28, 2024, at 9:15 AM** in the Trinity Room to celebrate the marriage of Neal and Lauren Rogers.

HYMN OF THE DAY is "The Church's One Foundation" (LSB 644) by the English pastor Samuel John Stone (1839-1900). Many of Stone's other hymns are not well known, but Queen Victoria asked him to write one for her son, the Prince of Wales (later King Edward VII) who had recovered from an almost deadly case of typhoid. "Lord of Our Soul's Salvation" was presented on February 27, 1872 in a grand service of thanksgiving at St. Paul's Cathedral. The tune AURELIA for "The Church's One Foundation" was composed by Samuel Sebastian Wesley (1810-1876), the grandson of Charles Wesley, the founder of the Methodist Church. The tune name, which means "golden," was chosen because the melody was originally intended for the hymn "Jerusalem the Golden." Samuel Wesley served as organist at several prominent English churches and was active as a composer and music editor. He also worked tirelessly to improve the status of church musicians, publishing many of his ideas in *A Few Words on Cathedral Music and the Music System of the Church* (1849).
