**NEXT WEEKEND** we celebrate The Eleventh Sunday after Pentecost. The hymn of the day is "Guide Me, O Thou Great Redeemer" (LSB 918). The scripture lessons for worship are:

Old Testament	Exodus 16:2-15	<i>Bread from Heaven</i>
Epistle	Ephesians 4:1-16	<i>Unity in the Body of Christ</i>
Gospel (sermon text)	John 6:22-35	<i>I Am the Bread of Life</i>

**HYMN OF THE DAY** is "Entrust Your Days and Burdens" (LSB 754) by Paul Gerhardt (1607-1676). Originally written in German, this hymn was translated into English by F. Samuel Janzow (1913-2001). Janzow was ordained in 1936 and served as pastor for two churches in London during the war years (1936-1947) and then for Trinity Lutheran in Trimont, Minnesota (1948-1954). In 1954, he was called to teach theology and English at Concordia Teachers College (now Concordia University Chicago) for the remainder of his career (1954-1981). Janzow studied at Oxford in 1965 and earned a Ph.D. in English from the University of Chicago in 1968. While he wrote a few original hymns, his greatest contribution to hymnody was his 35 translations from German to English. These hymns include "A Mighty Fortress" (LSB 656) and "Isaiah Mighty Seer" (LSB 960). Janzow's daughter Christine and her husband Paul have served Trinity several times as oboe and trombone soloists.
