The tune DARWALL'S 148TH is named after its composer, the Anglican pastor John Darwall (1731-1789) of Staffordshire (in the West Midlands region of England). The tune, originally written to accompany Psalm 148, is an example of the livelier singing that Darwall promoted for psalmody.
